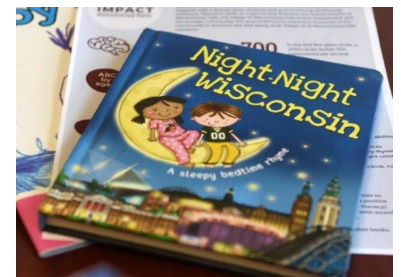


Free Brain Bag Early Literacy Resources Available through the Library
