



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of May 2021

21-012820 05-02-2021 Intentionally Pointing a Firearm Appleton Ave/Pilgrim Rd.

Victim reported that during a road rage incident an unknown male suspect pulled up next to her and pointed a shotgun at her from the driver's side window. The vehicle was described as a large red pick-up with loud exhaust. The victim was not able to provide a complete plate number and the suspect could not be located in the area.

21-012943 05-04-2021 Theft-False Representation N78 W17200 Block Wildwood Dr.

Unknown suspect convinced the victim that he was her grandson and needed money. The victim then sent \$5000.00 to an unknown subject out of state.

21-013123 05-06-2021 Theft N81 W15094 Appleton Ave.

Male customer at DJ's Goalpost reported that an unknown suspect stole \$1800.00 from his wallet. Investigation is on-going.

A male suspect was located sleeping in his vehicle which was parked with his bumper up against the wall of the business. The suspect admitted to driving, was administered field sobriety tests and eventual arrested for OWI 2nd offense.

A male suspect threw a speaker at the victim's car damaging the car. The suspect also pushed the victim's face into the ground causing injury. The suspect was arrested and turned over to the county jail.

Three suspects left the Woodman's with unpaid merchandise. Security escorted them back into the store to re-scan the items. The suspects began to make threats and pushed their way past store employees and fled in a red Chevrolet Malibu with no registration plates. Investigation is on-going.

21-013721 & 21-013759 05-12-2021 Stolen Vehicle N91W15851 Falls Pkwy

A citizen reported a suspicious male subject removing decorative stones from their residence on Pershing Ave. The vehicle the suspect left in was reported stolen earlier out of Milwaukee and later found abandoned at the Water Street Pub and Grill. A short time later another vehicle was stolen from the parking lot of Home2 Suite's. Based on the investigation these cases are related. The investigation is on-going.

Victim reported that an unknown suspect cut the lock off his locker at Planet Fitness and removed his car keys. The suspect then entered the victim's vehicle and removed his wallet. The suspect then proceeded to nearby businesses to complete fraudulent transactions with the victim's credit cards. Based on additional similar complaints and available video a suspect was identified. These investigations are on-going.

21-014096 05-10-2021 False Representation-Swindle W154 N6000 Block Marvel Dr.
The victim was contacted by an unknown suspect purported to be an employee of Microsoft and convinced the victim to purchase \$23,000.00 worth of gift cards. The victim received a second scam call where the caller unsuccessfully attempted to get the victim to transfer money to a subject in Hong Kong.

21-014143 05-06-2021 Disorderly & Resisting Officer N81W15094 Appleton Ave
At 1:17 a.m. Officers responded to a fight at DJ's Goalpost. Upon arrival one of the involved male suspects attempted to flee in his vehicle and began to resist the officers while they were trying to detain him. That suspect was eventually arrested. In addition, a female acquaintance of the arrested suspect tried to interfere and would not listen to the officer's commands to stay back. She was also arrested. The investigation determined that a third suspect who started the fight had left the scene. He was located and arrested a short distance away. All suspects were issued municipal citations.

21-014245 05-17-2021 Theft from Vehicle N84 W13562 Leon Rd.
An unknown suspect forcible entered two vehicles parked at Custom Home Heating and Air Inc. and stole close to \$5000.00 worth of tools and supplies. The suspect vehicle was reported to be a 2000's model, light colored extended cab pick-up truck. The investigation is on-going.

A female suspect drove into the parking lot and began urinating on the ground. A resident who believed the suspect was drunk, confronted the suspect and was eventually shoved by the suspect. As the suspect fled in her car she struck another parked car and did not stop. The suspect was later located and arrested for OWI by Fond Du Lac Sheriff's Deputies. A charge of disorderly Conduct was referred for charging.

The police department was notified by school officials of a student at Quest Academy that may be in possession of a handgun. Officers responded and worked with school officials to quickly locate the student and the handgun was recovered. The 19-year old student was booked on several charges and turned over to the county jail.

The victim reported that two firearms were taken from his garage over the period of six days. The firearms were entered as stolen and a neighborhood canvas was conducted.

Officer responded to an apartment to check the welfare of a female subject due to concerned family members. Upon entry a deceased male and female subject were located with apparent gunshot wounds. Investigation revealed the male occupant shot the female who was known to him then took his own life by a self-inflicted gunshot wound. News releases were provided to the media and public.

Officers responded to a burglar alarm at the gas station. Investigation revealed two masked suspects forced entry and removed a large quantity of cigarettes as well as cash from the register. A detective responded and the case is actively being investigated.

Officers responded to the report of a male suspect passed out in a vehicle. A crack pipe was located in plain view. Officers administered field sobriety tests and eventually arrested the suspect.
