



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of December 2021

21-034969 12-01-2021 Theft/Swindle N88 W15400 Block Menomonee Ave.

The victim called police to report that she was contacted by unknown suspects via phone who convinced her to withdraw approximately \$25,000 in cash to purchase gift cards and then provided the suspects with the gift card serial numbers. No suspect information could be determined and the case remains inactive.

21-035005 12-01-2021 Retail Theft N91 W16051 Falls Pkwy.

Two unknown suspects stole approximately \$10,000.00 worth of cologne and perfume from Ulta Beauty and fled the area. A similar incident with the same suspects was also reported in Greenfield. Photographs of the suspects were posted on social media. The suspects have not been identified and the case remains inactive.

21-035244 12-04-2021 Domestic Violence N85 W14100 Block Fond Du Lac Ave.

Officers were dispatched to a domestic violence incident where the victim was involved in a physical altercation with the suspect who grabbed and strangled her. The suspect fled from the scene and numerous attempts were made to locate and arrest him. The suspect could not be located and the case was referred out the district attorney's office for charging.

21-035370 12-05-2021 OWI 2nd, OAR, Bail Jumping, Drug Paraph. Main St./STH 145

Officers responded to a report of a one car accident where a single vehicle was located off the roadway and the driver was passed out behind the wheel. Investigation revealed the driver was under the influence of drugs and admitted to using heroin. The suspect had numerous open criminal cases requiring her not to commit crimes or use drugs, had a revoked driver's license, was in possession of drug paraphernalia and was on active probation. The suspect was arrested booked on numerous charges and turned over to the county jail.

21-035488 12-06-2021 OWI 1st, Possession of Drugs Hwy 145/Fond Du Lac Ave.

Officers responded to a report of a two-car vehicle crash. One of the drivers showed signs of impairment. The suspect driver was asked to perform field sobriety tests. Additionally, the police K9 alerted on the vehicle and suspected MDMA (Ecstasy/Molly) was located in a search of the vehicle. The suspect driver was arrested on OWI 1st and possession of drugs. The suspect was turned over to the county jail.

21-035833 12-10-2021 OWI 1st Parkway Dr./Hemlock Ct.

A subject called to report a subject was possibly driving under the influence of alcohol. Upon arrival to the area the suspect driver was located in the now disabled vehicle on a dead-end. Contact was made with the suspect driver who showed signs of impairment and was asked to perform field sobriety tests. The suspect was eventually arrested for OWI 1st, booked and released to a responsible adult.



21-035956 12-11-2021 OWI 3rd Hwy 41/Pilgrim Rd.

Officers responded to a one vehicle crash on the highway. Upon arrival, a vehicle was located off the roadway and was stuck up against a chain link fence. Upon contacting the suspect driver, he was attempting to start his vehicle. The driver showed signs of impairment and was asked to perform field sobriety tests. Based on those tests and observations the driver was arrested for OWI 3rd offense.

21-035962 12-11-2021 Felon in Poss. of a Firearm N57 W13800 Block Thurston Ave.

Officers were called to check on the welfare of a family member. Investigation revealed the suspect had armed themselves with a handgun and fled the residence. The suspect was later located, arrested after which the handgun was seized as evidence. The suspect had a previous felony conviction and was not allowed to be in possession of the firearm. The suspect was booked and turned over to the county jail.

21-036037 12-12-2021 Resisting/Obstructing Officer Appleton Ave./Garfield Dr.

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a speeding violation. The suspect driver provided a false name. Due to the inconsistent information the driver was providing, a mobile fingerprint identification device was brought to the scene. The driver then admitted to lying about his name which revealed he had a valid warrant through the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department for disorderly conduct. The driver was arrested and issued a citation for resisting/obstructing an officer for providing a false name.

21-036114 12-12-2021 OWI 1st Hwy 41/Main St.

Officers responded to a single vehicle rollover crash. Upon arrival the driver who showed signs of impairment and was asked to perform field sobriety tests. He was arrested and booked for OWI 1st offense and turned over to the county jail on a 12-hour hold.

21-036118 12-13-2021 Pursuit Mill Rd./Parkway Dr.

An officer located a stolen Hyundai vehicle and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle fled and the officer pursued it. Based on speeds and traffic conditions the officer terminated the pursuit. Neither the vehicle nor driver were located and the case remains inactive.

21-036180 12-13-2021 D.C. While Armed W124 N8145 Hwy 145

Woodman's called the police to report a disorderly conduct incident between two customers where one suspect customer displayed a handgun during the argument. The victim initially refused to cooperate or press charges, but police later re-contacted the victim who then provided the necessary details. Based on the investigation the suspect was identified, arrested and booked on charges of disorderly conduct while armed.

21-036360 12-15-2021 Stolen Vehicle N59 W13401 Manhardt Dr.

Milwaukee Police Department requested assistance regarding a possible stolen auto at a business in Menomonee Falls. The vehicle was reported stolen by Enterprise Rental as the vehicle had not been returned. The vehicle was located along with the suspect. The suspect was arrested and turned over to Milwaukee Police Department. The vehicle was towed from the scene.



21-036385 12-15-2021 Robbery N81 W15014 Appleton Ave.

Officers responded to a report of a robbery in which a vehicle was stolen. Upon arrival the victim advised that while she was sitting in her vehicle at the strip mall she was approached by two male suspects who forced her out of the car. The suspects appeared to imply they had weapons and fled in the victim's vehicle. The vehicle was equipped with OnStar and was quickly located in Milwaukee near 102nd St and Silver Spring Dr. Milwaukee and Menomonee Falls officers responded to the area and located the vehicle abandoned. The vehicle was processed for evidence and the investigation is on-going to attempt to identify the suspects.

21-03654 12-16-2021 D.C. While Armed N59 W13401 Manhardt Dr.

Officers responded to Union Supply for a report of a fight in the parking lot. It was learned that three suspects were involved in an argument and a physical fight, during which one of the suspects pulled out a handgun. All three suspects fled the scene prior to the arrival of the police. Phone contact was attempted with two of the three known suspects who refused to cooperate. Based on the information charges were referred out to the district attorney's office for disorderly conduct.

21-036524 12-16-2021 Child Neglect N88 W16600 Block Main St.

Officers responded to a report of an infant alone inside a vehicle that was not running. The temperature was 27 degrees. Officers located the infant and located the mother inside the Alumni Club drinking and determined the child had been left unattended for at least two hours. The mother appeared intoxicated and was arrested and booked for child neglect. The infant was determined to not need medical attention and was released to the father after involving Child Protective Services.

21-036591 12-18-2021 Attempt Vehicle Theft W162 N9235 Pershing Ave.

Officers responded to an attempt vehicle theft at Costco. The victim advised that three male suspects approached her while she was seated in her vehicle. The victim refused to unlock or open the door and the suspects fled the area. A detective responded to the scene and conducted the investigation. The investigation is on-going in attempt to identify the suspects.

Officers responded to a report of a burglary to a business. The business, Custom Home Heating and Air Inc., reported over \$18,000.00 worth of items stolen from the business. A detective responded to take over the investigation. The investigation is on-going and suspects have been tentatively identified.

21-0037264 12-24-2021 Possession of Drugs 6300 Block of Edgemont Dr.

Officers responded to a single vehicle crash. Upon arrival a vehicle was located that had crashed head on with a tree. Both the driver and passenger sustained injuries. The driver who suffered more severe injuries was found to be in possession of marijuana and other drug paraphernalia. No OWI could be substantiated and the suspect driver was transported to the hospital and issued municipal citations for the drug offenses.
