

Sec. 34-46. - False alarm fee.

The fee to be paid to the village for false alarms that result in responses by the police or fire departments shall be as established in section 42-34. When the chief of police or the fire chief determines that the cause of the false alarm was beyond the control of the permit holder, that false alarm may be exempted from this fee requirement.

Sec. 42-34. - Emergency services.

Alarm fees.

- (a) *False alarms.* The fees for false alarms occurring during any calendar year for permits issued under article III of chapter 34 of this Code that result in the response of fire department personnel and equipment shall be as follows:

0—3	No charge
4—5	\$100.00/per false alarm
6—9	\$200.00/per false alarm
10 or more	\$300.00/per false alarm.

- (b) *Other alarms.* For any false alarm resulting in the response of police department personnel, the following fees shall apply to the false alarms occurring during any calendar year:

0—3	No charge
4—5	\$75.00 per false alarm
6—9	\$150.00 per false alarm
10 or more	\$200.00 per false alarm

- (c) *Alarm permits.* The fees for alarm permits issued under article III, chapter 34 of this Code shall be as follows:

- (1) Residential alarm permits: \$10.00.
- (2) Commercial alarm permits: \$20.00.
- (3) Alarm monitoring service fee: \$15.00 per month.
- (4) A \$5.00 late fee shall be charged for any alarm permit payment that is delinquent 30 days after initial invoicing.
