



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of April 2022

22-008921 04-01-2022 Stolen Vehicle, Pursuit W124 N8145 Hwy 145

An officer was alerted to a possible stolen vehicle reported out of Jackson, MS in the Woodman's parking lot. Upon arrival the driver and vehicle were located. As the officer approached, the suspect driver entered the stolen vehicle and fled the area. A pursuit was initiated by the officer. The pursuit was terminated due to the recklessness and speed of the fleeing vehicle. Follow-up was conducted to identify the suspect. The case is inactive and no suspects have been arrested for this offense.

22-009031 04-03-2022 Stolen Vehicle, Poss. of Drugs N82 W13200 BLK Fond Du Lac Ave.

Officers responded to the area for the report of a stolen vehicle taken in Milwaukee. The vehicle was located along with two suspects. Upon approaching the vehicle, the officers smelled the strong odor of marijuana. The vehicle was confirmed stolen and a search of the vehicle revealed drugs, a scale, pills and cash. The driver was arrested and booked for operating a stolen vehicle, possession of cocaine, possession of marijuana, possession with intent to deliver and possession of drug paraphernalia. The driver was eventually turned over to the county jail. The passenger was arrested, booked and cited for possession of marijuana.

22-009057 04-03-2022 Suspect Vehicle N84 W17501 Menomonee Ave.

Officers were alerted to a vehicle wanted in connection with a homicide in the City of Milwaukee. The suspect vehicle was located and stopped in the parking lot of the YMCA. A high-risk stop was conducted where two suspects were taken into custody. In addition, two handguns were recovered from the vehicle. A Detective from Menomonee Falls as well as the Milwaukee Police Department responded to handle the remaining investigation to include interviews of the suspects. One subject was arrested and booked on charges of carrying a concealed weapon, possession of marijuana, resisting/obstructing and misdemeanor bail jumping. The other suspect was released with no charges.

22-009078 04-03-2022 OWI, Armed W/Intoxicated Fountain Blvd. & County Line Rd.

Officers responded to the area for a report of an abandoned, damaged vehicle in the middle of the roadway. The investigating officer found a loaded handgun in the center console of the abandoned vehicle. While on scene the suspect driver appeared and showed signs of intoxication. The driver admitted to colliding with a median wall and drinking. The suspect driver was asked to perform field sobriety tests and was eventually arrested for OWI 1st and going armed while intoxicated. The suspect posted bond and was released.

22-009561 04-09-2022 Stolen Vehicle, Pursuit Appleton Ave/Mary Dale Dr.

Officers responded to the area for a report of a stolen Illinois license plate taken in Milwaukee. The vehicle was located at a traffic light and officers attempted to stop the vehicle. During this time the stolen vehicle would slow down and the doors would open and then the vehicle would continue to drive. At one point the vehicle stopped and two juvenile suspects passengers fled on foot while the front driver and passenger fled in the vehicle. The two juveniles that fled on foot were located and issued citations for obstructing and curfew. They did not cooperate in identifying the suspect driver or other occupant and were later released to their parent.



22-009757 04-11-2022 Stolen Vehicle, Pursuit W124 N8145 Hwy 145

Officers responded to the area for a report of a suspect vehicle involved in several retail thefts in Grafton. The suspect and vehicle were located in the Woodman's parking lot. Upon attempting to stop the vehicle the suspect driver fled. A pursuit was initiated. Shortly after the start of the pursuit the suspect driver took a sharp turn causing a tire to blowout, slowing her speed down. Officers pursued the vehicle into Milwaukee for approximately eight miles. The suspect driver eventually stopped, fled from the vehicle and attempted to enter another citizen's vehicle where officers were able to take her into custody. The suspect initially provided a false name, but was eventually booked on charges of fleeing and resisting/obstructing and turned over to the county jail.

22-009840 4-12-2022 OWI 2nd Appleton Ave./Jacobson Dr.

Officers contacted a driver that had stopped his vehicle in traffic on Appleton Ave. The suspect driver showed signs of intoxication and was asked to perform field sobriety tests. The driver was eventually arrested for OWI 2nd. The driver was taken back to the police department where he provided a breath sample, was issued citations and released to a responsible adult.

22-009944 04-13-2022 Homicide by Negligent Vehicle Oper. Lannon Rd./High Point Ave.

Officers responded to the area after Washington County Sheriff's deputies terminated a pursuit that had started in their jurisdiction. The area was checked and the fleeing vehicle was located crashed off the roadway. The passenger was found deceased and the driver was arrested and booked for homicide by negligent operation of a motor vehicle. The suspect was taken to the Waukesha County jail. A press release was sent out regarding this incident.

22-009967 04-13-2022 Retail theft, Possession of Drugs N83 W15701 Appleton Ave.

Officers responded to a report of a retail theft involving two suspects at the Appleton Ave. Walgreens. The suspects were no longer on scene, but a witness provided a vehicle description. Another officer working observed the suspects in the same vehicle parked at the Walgreens located off of Silver Spring Dr. Contact was made with the suspects and it was determined that they stole approximately \$1800.00 worth of merchandise from the store. One of the detained suspects requested to use the bathroom in an effort to discard drugs before officers found them on her person. This suspect was arrested and booked on charges of retail theft, possession of fentanyl, possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of an illegally obtained prescription and a probation violation. She was turned over to the county jail. The other suspect was arrested and booked on charges of retail theft and released.

22-010257 04-16-2022 Resisting/Obstructing Claremore Cir./Pilgrim Rd.

A traffic stop was conducted for a speed violation and expired registration. The officer contacted the suspect driver who acknowledged that she was aware of the expired registration. The driver then refused to identify herself or provide any form of identification. After several attempts to verbally gain compliance, a supervisor was called to the scene. The female driver was eventually arrested for resisting/obstructing and positively identified. The driver continued to be uncooperative during the booking process and was eventually taken to the county jail.



22-010396 04-18-2022 Resisting/Obstructing W124 N8145 Hwy 145

Officers responded to Woodman's for the report of a vehicle displaying a stolen plate taken in Milwaukee. The vehicle was located and contact was made with the occupants. The suspect driver provided a false name which required a mobile fingerprint identifier to be used. Once his correct identity was determined, he was found to have three valid warrants. The suspect driver was arrested, issued a citation for obstructing and turned over to the county jail. The plates were confiscated from the vehicle.

22-010927 04-24-2022 OWI 2nd, Resisting N61 W15100 Block Wigwam Dr.

Officers were dispatched to the area to look for a suspect (in a vehicle) who had left with her boyfriend's dog and was driving around intoxicated. Officers located and stopped the vehicle near the residence. The suspect showed signs of intoxication and was asked to perform field sobriety tests. After completing the tests, officers went to handcuff the suspect who tried to run towards her house. Officers were able to prevent her from running, but she continued to physically resist. She was eventually handcuffed and booked on charges of OWI 2nd and resisting/obstructing. She posted bond and was released to a responsible adult.

22-011076 04-22-2022 Physical Abuse of a Child N90 W17000 Block Appleton Ave.

Officers were informed that a suspect who had previously been arrested around Christmas for physical abuse of a child had committed additional offenses that were captured on video. The suspect was currently on bond with conditions not to commit any additional crimes. The suspect was located, arrested and booked on charges of bail jumping, physical abuse of a child-repeated offenses, causing mental harm to a child and physical abuse of a child-reckless causation of bodily harm. Suspect was turned over to the county jail.

22-011324 04-29-2022 Carrying Concealed Weapon Silver Spring Dr./Williams Pl.

A vehicle was stopped due to the registered owner not having a valid driver's license. Upon contacting the driver, the driver went to retrieve proof of insurance from the glove compartment. As the glove compartment was opened a handgun was observed. The driver did not have a CCW permit. The driver was arrested and booked for carrying a concealed weapon. The driver was also issued a citation for operating with a suspended license. The suspect was turned over to the county jail.
