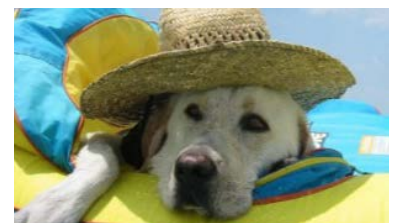
**FIT in the Parks
