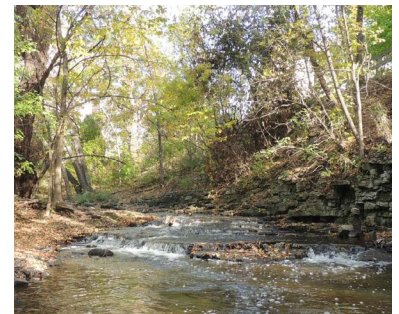
Storm Water Utility Fee Approved
