



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of October 2023

23-024920 10-07-2023 Possession of Drugs and Paraphernalia, Operating After Revocation, Felony Bail Jumping W15500 Block Appleton Ave.

An officer stopped a vehicle for displaying expired registration. Upon contacting the driver, the officer noted the strong odor of marijuana. A probable cause search by the officer revealed marijuana, drug paraphernalia and an unprescribed narcotic. The suspect was on bond for felony eluding and found to have a revoked driver's license. The suspect was arrested, booked on numerous charges and transported out to the Waukesha County jail.

23-024944 10-08-2023 Battery Domestic Violence, Carrying Concealed Weapon, Go Armed While Intoxicated, Operating While Intoxicated N80 W14900 Block Appleton Ave.

Officers responded to a domestic violence incident where the suspect struck the victim causing pain. The suspect fled in a vehicle which was located and stopped by other officers in the area. The suspect displayed signs of intoxication and admitted to being armed with a handgun. The suspect had an expired CCW permit and failed his field sobriety tests. He was arrested, booked on numerous charges and transported out to the Waukesha County jail.

23-025209 10-11-2023 Armed Robbery N56 W14150 Silver Spring Dr.

Officers responded to a Kwik Trip where the victim reported that he was approached by two males suspects as he sat in his vehicle. The suspects demanded the victim's keys while displaying a handgun. The victim provided the suspects with a set of keys (not for that vehicle) and ran into the store. The suspects were unable to start the victim's car and fled. It was later determined that the suspects had arrived in a different stolen vehicle reported out of Milwaukee. Milwaukee Police Department later pursued the suspect vehicle resulting in arrests. This case is still actively being investigated in confirming suspect's identities for charging purposes.

23-025705 10-18-2023 Operate Vehicle Without Owner's Consent, Probation Violation N95 W17061 Falls Pkwy.

Officers responded to the area for a Flock alert on a stolen GMC box truck reported out of Wauwatosa. Officers located the vehicle and stopped it near the Penny Mustard parking lot. The driver was detained during the investigation and follow-up with the Wauwatosa Police Department to confirm the stolen status of the truck.. The suspect driver was arrested and found to be on probation for the same felony offense for operating vehicle without owner's consent. The suspect was booked and transported out to the Waukesha County jail. The vehicle was towed from the scene.

23-025910 10-20-2023 Battery (Special Circumstances) Elder Person N81 W15094 Appleton Ave.

Officers responded to DJ's Goalpost to investigate a battery. Investigation revealed that a known suspect struck the elderly victim causing the victim to fall and sustain injuries. Multiple witnesses were interviewed and positively identified the suspect. The suspect, days later, turned himself into the police department where he was booked and transported out to the Waukesha County jail.



23-026041 10-22-2023 Possession of Cocaine & Fentanyl N91 W15851 Fall Pkwy

Officers responded to Home 2 Suites by Hilton for a medical call originating from one of the guest's rooms. Upon arrival officers observed an unresponsive female and provided lifesaving measures. The other male suspect provided information on the female patient and was eventually found to be in possession of cocaine and fentanyl. It was learned the female had overdosed after using these drugs found in the room. The male suspect was booked on drug charges and transported out to the Waukesha County jail. The female survived the overdose incident and was not charged.

23-026191 10-24-2023 Operating While Intoxicated 5th Offenses Lilly Rd./Good Hope Rd.

Officers responded to the area for a report of two people physically fighting in the road. Upon arrival it was determined the male driver was intoxicated was trying to get his intoxicated girlfriend in the car. The suspect admitted to driving and was asked to perform field sobriety tests. He was eventually arrested for OWI 5th offense and was taken to the hospital for a blood draw. The suspect was booked and turned over to the Waukesha County jail. The vehicle was towed from the scene.

23-026200 10-24-2023 Vehicle Theft, Theft, Fraud N85 W17800 Block Ann Ave.

Officers responded to the victim's residence for the report of a vehicle theft and a theft of a purse. The victim advised that her roommate allowed an unknown suspect in their residence that he met from a dating app. After that suspect left, the victim noticed her purse was missing from the residence and her vehicle was also missing. The vehicle was entered a stolen and was later recovered in Milwaukee. The purse was not located inside the vehicle. Unauthorized charges had also been completed with the victim's credit cards. The vehicle was processed for evidence and the case is still under investigation.

23-026285 10-26-2023 Vehicle Theft N79 W15400 Block Deerfield Trl.

Officers responded to the report of a vehicle theft. The victim advised that some time overnight their Toyota vehicle was stolen from the street in front of the residence. The vehicle had the key inside it and there was no known suspect information. Officers conducted neighbor contacts and the vehicle was entered as stolen. The vehicle has not yet been recovered at this time.

23-026598 10-29-2023 Operating While Intoxicated Causing Injury I 41/Main St.

Officers responded to Interstate 41 for the report of single vehicle rollover accident. Officers located a vehicle with two occupants. The passenger suffered significant injuries and was trapped inside the vehicle. Due to the circumstances, the fire department requested Flight for Life to respond to transport that passenger. The driver had already exited the vehicle and displayed signs of intoxication. At one point he attempted to cover his mouth with his shirt while talking to officers. The suspect driver refused to complete field sobriety tests and was arrested for OWI causing injury. He refused a blood draw so a warrant was obtained and a forced blood draw was completed. The suspect was booked, issued citations and transported out to the Waukesha County jail.
