The deadline for all natural Christmas trees to be set out by the road for pick up has been extended to Sunday, January 14<sup>th</sup>. Discarded Christmas trees will be picked up thereafter as time permits. Trees must be clean of decorations, lights, stands, tinsel, garland, wire, plastic bags, etc. Wreaths must be disposed of with regular garbage.

To license your dog, submit a completed application for a dog license and a \$10 fee per dog (\$15 for unneutered/unspayed dogs) to the Clerk Services Department.
