



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of December 2023

23-029443 12-05-2023 Theft by Fraud N65 W13600 Block Lilly Creek Dr.

The victim contacted police to advise that they had been defrauded after having invested thousands of dollars in bitcoin purchases. The victim attempted to track their purchases through the app and learned they were no longer able to login. After some additional research the victim realized they had been scammed. Due to the difficulty of identifying suspects involved in internet crimes, this case remains unresolved.

23-029482 12-05-2023 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, Go Armed While Intoxicated W161 N8800 Block Hayes Ave.

Officers were sent to investigate a domestic violence incident. It was determined that the intoxicated suspect was engaged in an argument with the victim. During this argument the suspect fired a handgun at the victim, but missed. The suspect left the scene and later turned himself in. The suspect was arrested, booked and turned over to the Waukesha County jail.

23-029806 12-11-2023 Carrying a Concealed Weapon Appleton Ave./University Dr.

An officer stopped a vehicle for a registration violation and contacted the driver. The officer noted the odor of marijuana during this contact. The suspect driver admitted to having a handgun in the vehicle and did not have a concealed carry permit. The suspect driver was arrested, booked, posted bond and was released.

23-029871 12-11-2023 Fleeing/Eluding Mill Rd./Willow Ct.

An officer attempted to stop a gray Chevrolet vehicle that had no registration plates. The vehicle fled at a high rate of speed and the officer initiated a pursuit. Due to the suspects speed and heavy traffic the pursuit was terminated. The vehicle and driver were not identified and no arrests have been made.

23-029941 12-13-2023 Stolen Vehicle, Bail Jumping Appleton Ave./Good Hope Rd.

Officers responded to a FLOCK alert for a stolen Honda reported out of Waukesha. Officers located the van and conducted a traffic stop. The suspect driver was detained and interviewed. The stolen status of the van was confirmed and the driver was eventually arrested for driving a stolen vehicle. It was determined that the suspect driver was in violation of an open felony case and was booked on bail jumping charges as well. The suspect was transported out to the Waukesha County jail. The vehicle was returned to the owner.

23-030465 12-14-2023 Theft by Fraud W172 N7500 Block Shady Ln.

The victim contacted police to report being defrauded out of thousands of dollars. The victim advised that they initiated Facebook correspondence with a suspect purporting to be someone who requested payment for services they never intended to provide. The victim further advised they sent a large sum of cash via the US Postal Service. Due to the reporting time officers were able to contact the receiving postal office who were able to intercept the money, which was returned to the owner. Due to a lack of information this case is inactive.



**23-03044 12-19-2023 Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Electronic Weapon
Fond Du Lac Ave./Danell Dr.**

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and contacted the driver. The officer noted the smell of marijuana coming from the vehicle. A probable cause search revealed suspected marijuana and an electric stun gun. The suspect did not have a concealed carry permit and was arrested, booked and transported out to the Waukesha County jail.

23-030516 12-19-2023 Stolen Vehicle, Warrant Arrest 17700 Block Shady Ln.

Officer responded to a FLOCK alert for a stolen plate displayed reported out of Milwaukee. The vehicle was located and contact was made with the suspect driver. Investigation revealed that the vehicle plates were stolen out of Milwaukee and the vehicle was reported stolen out of Greenfield. The wanted check revealed the driver had two valid arrest warrants. The stolen status was confirmed and the suspect was arrested, booked and transported to the Waukesha County jail.

23-030699 12-22-2023 Armed Robbery W140 N9500 Block Fountain Blvd.

The victim contacted police to advise that they had been a victim of a robbery. The victim advised that they corresponded with the known suspect through Facebook to purchase a vehicle. Arrangements were made to meet to exchange cash for the vehicle. When the victim arrived at the location they entered the suspect's vehicle, a gun was held to their head and one of the suspects utilized the victim's phone to transfer money via a cash app. The victim was released afterwards. This case is actively being investigated.

**23-030722 12-21-2023 2nd Degree Intentional Homicide, Resisting/Obstructing
N90 W17100 Block Saint Thomas Dr.**

Officers responded to the report of a subject stabbed. Investigation revealed that the suspect girlfriend stabbed her victim boyfriend in the chest with a knife during an argument. The victim was treated for life-threatening injuries and survived his injuries. The suspect provided a false name and was found to have valid warrants. The suspect was arrested, booked and transported out the Waukesha County jail.
