Community building is also about opportunities to gather and make connections with neighbors. This summer's calendar is packed with a wide variety of FREE festivals, concerts, movies, markets, and more for residents and visitors to enjoy. # Summer Reminders & Service Updates

## Yard Waste Permits

Yard Waste Permits were mailed in February to each Menomonee Falls property owner. The permit allows residents to dispose of yard waste 35 times in a season (April–December) for no fee at the Orchard Ridge composting facility. Please note: Village residents must provide identification showing proof of Menomonee Falls residency. Have your ID ready to show the scale house attendant upon arrival. If you do not arrive with a permit, all fees will be charged. All businesses are excluded from this program.

2024 Orchard Ridge Composting Facility Program located at N96W13073 County Line Road

- Credit cards are the only acceptable form of payment – cash and checks no longer accepted
- Residents will be allowed one free visit per day  
After the free visit, additional yard waste will be charged at a rate of \$0.015 per pound, minimum of \$3.00.
- Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday, 6:30 am–4 pm & Saturday 7 am–11:45 am
- No large stumps or logs over 6" will be accepted

## Dogs in Parks

Dogs are permitted in parks if they are on leashes no longer than 6 feet. The Village has 16 pet waste disposal systems in parks which include bags to pick up pet waste. It is the dog owner's responsibility to clean up after pets. Menomonee Park,



which is operated by Waukesha County, has a fully fenced dog exercise area. Learn more about this area at [waukeshacounty.gov/landandparks/park-system](http://waukeshacounty.gov/landandparks/park-system)

## Free Mulch

The Village manages a brush grinding operation which produces shredded wood mulch for residents. The mulch is FREE, clean, and good quality. Menomonee Falls residents can help themselves to mulch at the end of MacArthur Drive through October. ## Recycling & Disposal Requirements

Things like chemicals, electronics, and appliances cannot be disposed of using your curbside collection service, so residents are encouraged to utilize the following resources to determine the most appropriate way to dispose of these types of items.

## In-Person Absentee Voting

In-person absentee voting takes place two weeks before each election and ends on the Friday preceding the election. Voters may come into Village Hall, show proof of identification, and receive an absentee ballot. Remember, you must be registered to vote before requesting an absentee ballot. ## Park Basics

Menomonee Falls maintains [16 public parks](#) which provide a wide variety of recreation opportunities for residents and visitors. Park users should abide by the following rules:

- Hours 6 am to a half hour after sunset, unless otherwise posted
- Dogs allowed in Menomonee Falls park system on a leash not exceeding 6 feet in length. Owners are responsible for picking up after dogs
- No alcohol consumption without permit
- No alcohol in athletic field areas
- No littering, removal of vegetation, disorderly conduct, or amplified broadcast beyond 20 feet
- Fires permitted in grills only. Grills are provided in Rotary Park only. Charcoal must be properly disposed of
- Tents may be erected only with the prior approval of the Village (and may require a permit)
- No moonwalks, bounce houses, inflatable structures, or slip & slides
- Power strips and extension cords are prohibited within picnic shelters

## Park Shelter Reservations

## Explore Village Parks & Trails

With the longer days and warmer temperatures, now is a great time to check out some of the dozens of public parks and trails in Menomonee Falls. There are over 30 miles of trails in our community including the eastern extent of the 16 mile Bugline Recreation Trail and the Menomonee River Parkway Trail which links downtown and Rotary Park.

Our hundreds of acres of parkland offer natural beauty, athletic facilities, picnic areas, and more. For a glimpse into Village history, stroll down Main Street, stop by the Mill Pond, visit the Garwin Mace Lime Kilns, or head north to Old Falls Village Park. ## Centennial Plaza Renovation

Construction will move forward in 2024 on a series of improvements at **Centennial Plaza** (design pictured in renderings below). The renovation of the plaza will support downtown events with a new concrete vendor / food truck area, shade structures, seating improvements, lighting installations, a flag pole, and landscaping updates.



## Other Public Projects

### Street Reconstruction, Water Mains, & More

In 2024, the Village is reconstructing portions of County Line Road, Wheeler Drive, and Menomonee River Parkway. The Village is also repaving and sealing many streets throughout the community, planning for the next phase of construction at Aero Park, and replacing water mains on Shady Lane, Main Street, Dardis Avenue, and Menomonee Avenue.

## Business Expansion Update

- Alto-Shaam's 111,697 square foot building addition is creating office and warehouse space, and it is expected to accommodate 44 new full-time employees.
- Laser Center's new industrial facility on east Main Street will have 30 full-time workers.
- Third Space Brewing is opening a brew house this summer in the mixed use development at the corner of Good Hope Road and Appleton Avenue.
- Boucher Ford's new car dealership on Leon Road will support additional inventory and an expanded service facility.

Community Education & Recreation (CE & Rec) staff have a great summer of programs and activities planned for youth and adults of all ages! ### Community Center & Riverside Project

On Monday, May 13, 2024, the SDMF School Board approved a debt defeasance (a pre-payment of old referendum debt) to save interest and create room in the levy and approved the CE and Rec/Riverside expansion. - CE and Rec facilities are expanded and improved to create even more opportunities for our community
- Support the increasing size of Riverside Elementary
- Create separate and secure facilities to allow simultaneous CE and Rec and school programming
- Defeasance saves the taxpayers over 12 years \$3.3 million in interest
- Creates no new debt while decreasing the mill rate





## Citizen Police Academy

The 14<sup>th</sup> class of the Menomonee Falls Police Citizen Academy will commence this September. Our Citizen Police Academy is intended to teach our citizens about police work while building a better rapport with the community. To be clear, the Citizen Academy is not designed as a preparatory class for individuals who wish to become law enforcement officers. Rather, the class is an educational and informative offering for adults who reside or work in our Village and desire to learn more about our Police Department.

The Citizen Academy will cover a plethora of subjects including Police Administration, Traffic Enforcement, Crash Investigation, Use of Force, Search & Seizure, Firearms, Tactical Enforcement Unit, Special Investigations Bureau, Drug Enforcement Unit, Neighborhood Watch, Facial Recognition, Analytics & the Future of Policing, Crime Scene Investigations, K9 Unit, Evidence Processing, Civil Disturbance Unit, and much more.

The Citizen Academy begins on Tuesday, September 10<sup>th</sup> and will run for 12 weeks. Most classes start at 6 pm and are no longer than 2-3 hours. The final session will include a graduation ceremony featuring the MFPD Honor Guard. ## COLD CASE SOLVED

Special congratulations to Menomonee Falls Sergeant Chris Bellows for earning the Death Investigator of the Year award at this year's Wisconsin Association of Homicide Investigators (WAHI) conference. This award is derived following Sgt. Bellow's tenure in the Special Investigations Bureau, where his hard work, dedication, and collaborative effort with other detectives and agencies helped solve a decades-old homicide. On the evening of November 3rd, 1966, Diane Olkwitz (19-year-old) was found murdered at her workplace, Kenworth Manufacturing Co., a metal stamping plant in the 13700 block of West Silver Spring Drive in Menomonee Falls. She had been stabbed repeatedly, and the suspect was unknown. This case had always remained open with detectives searching for additional clues throughout the past decades.

Sgt. Bellows, with help from local, state, and federal officials, using newly acquired technology, was able to identify the suspect through DNA evidence and forensic genealogy. The suspect responsible for the murder of Olkwitz was positively identified as Clarence Mark Tappendorf. He was discovered to be a delivery driver in 1966 for Clairmont Transfer Company whose route included Olkwitz's employer. He died in 2008 at the age of 80. Tappendorf was also found to be responsible for the death of a female teenager in the City of Milwaukee in 1971. Though this case was tragic, we are extremely grateful to bring closure to the family of Diane Olkwitz.



# Fire Department Equipment Spotlight: Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus

The only piece of equipment that has no alternative for a firefighter is their Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA). We have different hose lines, lots of ladders, numerous medications, and three sources of water in addition to extinguishers as alternatives, but our SCBA is our only way to breath in a hazardous atmosphere, so a failure puts a FF on the sidelines.

MFFD has received a grant to replace the SCBA. The current inventory of SCBA in use are at the end of their 10-year life as recommended by the National Fire Protection Agency (NFPA) and have required numerous repairs as they age. The MFFD will have an inventory of 54 complete SCBA, with 54 spare bottles to use at fire scenes. Each firefighter is assigned their own face piece as part of their Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and the purchase includes receiving extra face pieces as our staffing changes and to maintain coverage during service intervals.

The new SCBAs were purchased after applying for and receiving a grant to cover \$555,000 of the \$610,000 total. The grant asks the Village to shoulder only 10% of the cost of replacement. The new SCBA includes technology allowing each FF to 'link' to a specific SCBA every shift and allow the Shift Commander to monitor crews and their air usage and levels during operations. This allows the Shift Commander to anticipate resource needs at a scene and plan ahead to request more firefighting companies to the scene if necessary.

These new SCBA also have integral temperature monitoring and thermal imaging. Advances in firefighting gear have better insulated firefighters from temperature rise. Now wearers have a constant subjective measure of the ambient temperature, and that crucial information is also relayed in real time to the Shift Commander. This allows for faster and better tactical decisions in operations.



The MSA Control Module (shown above) contains an analog and digital pressure gauge, the Thermal Imaging Camera, a Personal Alert Safety System (PASS) to locate a down FF, and the ability to add communication modules for Bluetooth, RFID, Near Field Communication and long range radio.
