**Menomonee Falls Fire Department (Non-Emergency) Telephone Service Interruption
July 9 – 11, 2024**

As part of the Menomonee Falls Fire Department Station 99 (headquarters) renovation, the department's Information Technology area will be serviced and cleaned. During this time, incoming non-emergency calls will not be connected to fire stations or personnel. The outage will be observed from Tuesday, July 9th through end of business Thursday, July 11th.

9-1-1 service WILL NOT be interrupted. For emergencies, you should always dial 9-1-1.

Should you need to address non-emergency, business-related information during this time, please dial the Menomonee Falls Police Department business office at: 262-532-8700. Police Department personnel will be able to take your information and relay it to the fire department.

In order to accommodate daily business, the Fire Department's administrative team will be working at the outlying stations during the phone-system outage.
