



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of March 2025

25-005220 3-1-2025 Possession of Marijuana / Carry a Concealed Weapon

Appleton Ave / Woosencraft Dr

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a registration violation and detected the odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. The vehicle and the driver were searched for evidence of the drug law violation and marijuana was found on his person. The driver also admitted there was a semi-automatic handgun underneath the driver's seat and he did not possess a CCW permit. The driver was arrested, booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department, posted bond and released.

25-005605 3-6-2025 Resisting an Officer, Disorderly Conduct, Criminal Damage to Property, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of an Illegally Obtained Narcotic Drug

N85W16100 block Appleton Ave

Officers were dispatched to a gas station for a disorderly person inside the store. Officers attempted to escort the disorderly person out of the business, however, he punched and tackled the gas station employee. The suspect resisted arrest and had to be physically restrained. Once the suspect was in custody, officers located marijuana and illegally obtained prescription medications in his possession. The suspect was transported to the Waukesha County Jail and charges are being referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office.

25-006423 3-15-2025 Possession of Marijuana & Drug Paraphernalia

Pilgrim Rd/Ridge Rd

An officer conducted a traffic stop of a vehicle after observing several equipment violations. The officer made contact with the driver and detected an odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. The officer conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and located several items consistent with drug paraphernalia. Some of the items contained suspected marijuana. The officer conducted a presumptive test of the suspected marijuana, and it tested positive for the presence of THC. The driver was arrested, booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department, issued several municipal citations and was released from custody.

25-006493 3-16-2025 Possession of an Electronic Weapon & Possession of Marijuana

Appleton Ave / Pilgrim Rd

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a speeding violation. Upon contacting the driver, the officer detected an odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. The officer conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and located an electronic weapon, commonly referred to as a "Taser", and suspected marijuana. The officer determined that the driver did not possess a CCW permit. The driver was arrested and booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department. The officer conducted a presumptive test of the suspected marijuana and it tested positive for the presence of THC. The driver was transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-006684 3-18-2025 Battery, Strangulation – Domestic Violence Related

Appleton Ave / Pilgrim Rd

A woman reported that her boyfriend punched her, strangled her, and bit her while the two of them were traveling through Menomonee Falls in a vehicle. The suspect was on active probation; however, the suspect was unable to be located. The suspect was located by the Milwaukee Police Department the following day and arrested. Custody was turned over to the Menomonee Falls Police Department. The suspect was then booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department, conveyed to Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital for medical clearance and transported to the Waukesha County Jail on a probation hold. Criminal charges are being referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office.

25-007143 3-24-2025 Eluding, 2nd Deg. Recklessly Endangering Safety, Bail Jumping

Silver Spring Dr / Butternut Dr

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a registration violation. The driver fled eastbound on Silver Spring Drive and the officer briefly pursued the vehicle. The officer terminated the pursuit as the vehicle sped into Milwaukee County. Upon checking the area for any possible crashes, the officer came upon a crash involving the suspect vehicle that had fled. The driver was arrested at the crash scene with the assistance of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department. The crash caused injury to the passengers in the vehicle. The driver admitted to using crack cocaine before driving. A consensual blood draw was obtained at Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital. The driver was booked and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-007284 3-26-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 2nd Offense

Appleton Ave / Lilly Rd

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a registration violation and observed signs of impairment from the driver. The driver conducted standardized field sobriety tests and impairment was observed. The driver was arrested for OWI-2nd offense. At the police department, the driver submitted to an evidentiary chemical breath test that provided a reported value of .19 g/210 L.

25-007411 & 25-007413 3-27-2025 Operating a Motor Vehicle without Owner's Consent, Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Possession of Marijuana

Pilgrim Rd / Robinhood Dr

A traffic stop was conducted on a vehicle that did not have registration plates displayed. The officer checked the VIN and discovered the vehicle was stolen out of Watertown, WI. A search of the stolen vehicle yielded marijuana and a shotgun. Both occupants were arrested, booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

Officers responded to FedEx for a FLOCK hit of a stolen license plate on a vehicle. The suspect vehicle was located unoccupied in the parking lot of FedEx. Officers checked the VIN and confirmed it was stolen. Officers determined that an employee was operating the vehicle and provided officers with several untruthful statements. The driver was arrested, booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

An officer conducted a traffic stop for an equipment violation. The officer detected the odor of marijuana from inside the vehicle and conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle. The officer located a satchel containing a non-serialized 9mm handgun. The officer confirmed that the driver did not possess a valid CCW permit. The driver was arrested, booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.
