



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of April 2025

25-007906 4-2-2025 Operating While Intoxicated - 3rd Offense, Possession of THC

Jacobson Dr/Appleton Ave

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a registration violation. The officer noticed signs of impairment, and standardized field sobriety tests were conducted. The officer confirmed the driver was impaired, and a PBT sample was obtained, with a reported value of 0.128. The driver was arrested for OWI – 3rd offense and possession of marijuana, which was located on his person following his arrest. The arrestee was transported to Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital for a blood draw. The arrestee was then booked at the police department and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-008176 4-5-2025 Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon

N88W14800 blk Main St

An intoxicated subject discharged a round from his firearm into his apartment door after thinking people were trying to break in. The individual was arrested for endangering safety by use of a dangerous weapon and conveyed to Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital for a blood draw. The arrestee refused a consensual blood draw, and a warrant was obtained. The arrestee was booked and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-008248 4-6-2025 Battery by Negligent Use of a Weapon, Criminal Damage to Property – Domestic Violence Related

An adult male used a knife to stab his mother in the back during a domestic violence incident. The male party also pushed his mother into a dresser and threw a mirror at her, which shattered. The woman required stitches and medical treatment. The male party was arrested, booked, and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-008372 4-7-2025 Disorderly Conduct, Bail Jumping

Ascension Hospital

Officers responded to Ascension Hospital for the report of a disorderly patient. Officers encountered an individual who was combative with medical staff and refused to leave the facility. Officers requested the individual leave the facility, however, he refused. He was arrested for disorderly conduct and found to have an open misdemeanor case. He was transported to Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital for medical clearance and then turned over to the Waukesha County Jail.

Officers responded to a retail theft in progress. Officers attempted to stop the suspect as he exited the store, however, he fled to a nearby stolen vehicle, and a pursuit was initiated. The pursuit was terminated near HWY 145 and 107th St. The investigation remains ongoing.

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle operated at night with no lights illuminated and making an improper turn. The driver displayed signs of impairment, and standardized field sobriety tests were conducted. The driver was arrested for operating while intoxicated – 1st offense. He was booked, provided an evidentiary breath test of 0.19, cited, and released to a sober adult.

Main St/Esquire Rd

An officer attempted to stop a vehicle for a speeding violation, however, the vehicle fled. As the vehicle sped away, it turned off its headlights and taillights. The officer terminated the pursuit due to the unsafe driving conditions. The officer later conducted a FLOCK search and obtained a photograph of the suspect vehicle and license plate. The officer then responded to the registered owner's address in the City of Milwaukee and contacted the suspected driver. The suspect admitted to driving the vehicle in Menomonee Falls and observing the patrol squad he passed on Main Street. He also admitted to turning off his headlights to avoid apprehension. The driver was arrested, booked, and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-009136 4-16-2025 Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent, Probation Violation

Good Hope Rd/Narrow Ln

Officers were dispatched to a FLOCK alert for a stolen vehicle in the area of Appleton Ave/Good Hope Rd. The vehicle was located unoccupied in the area of Narrow Ln. Officers began interviewing employees of a nearby business and located a suspect who admitted to driving the vehicle to this location. The driver told officers he received the vehicle from his girlfriend, however, he could not provide accurate contact information for her to verify this information. Officers discovered he was on probation for taking and driving a motor vehicle without consent. The driver was arrested, booked, and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-009641 4-22-2025 Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 2nd Offense

Main St/Patton Dr

An officer stopped a vehicle for expired registration, unsafe lane deviation, and operating without headlights illuminated at night. The officer detected signs of impairment, and the driver admitted to drinking alcohol before driving. The driver performed standardized field sobriety tests and was arrested for operating while intoxicated – 2nd offense. The driver submitted to an evidentiary chemical test of his breath that returned at 0.17. The driver was booked, cited, and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-010498 4-30-2025 Possession of Fentanyl, MDMA, and Marijuana

County Line Rd/Falls Parkway

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that was not displaying a front license plate. The officer requested a nearby police canine respond to the scene for a sniff of the vehicle. The canine alerted the handler, and officers searched the vehicle. The search yielded a marijuana blunt and an unmarked, prescription pill bottle containing several unidentified pills. A field evidence technician performed a presumptive test of the pills and determined the pills to tested positive for the presence of MDMA and Fentanyl. The driver was arrested, booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department, and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.
