What's On Tap for the Falls this Summer?

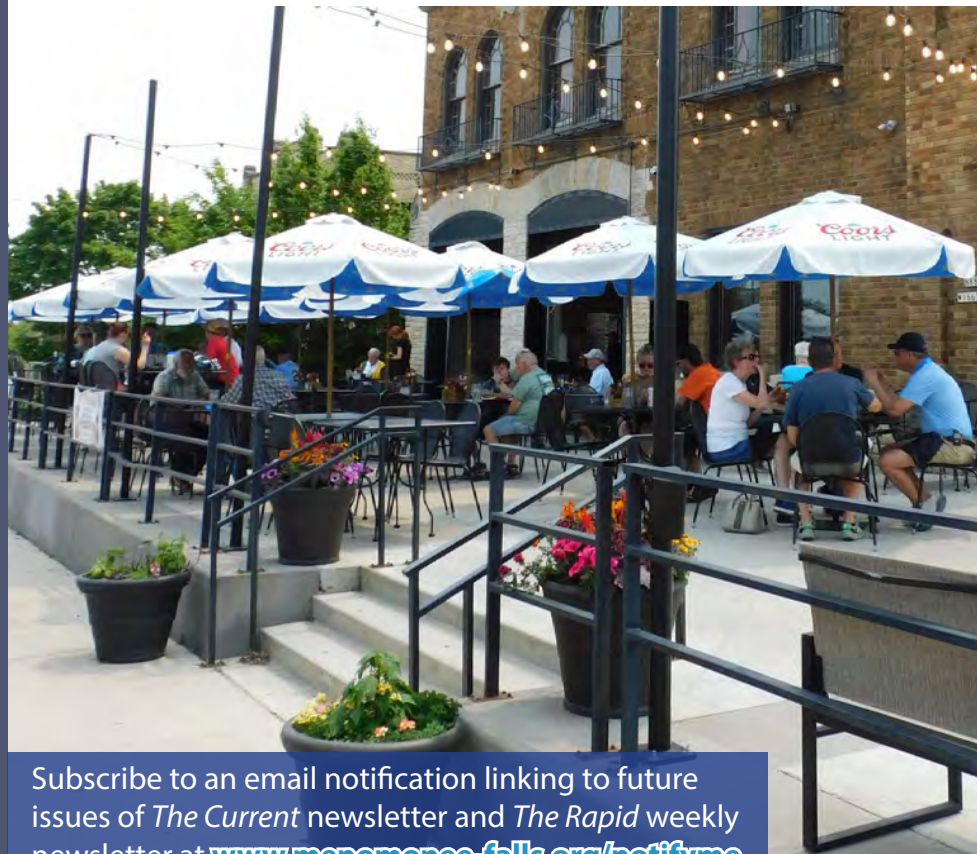

Summer Reminders & Village Service Updates

Yard Waste Permits

Yard Waste Permits were mailed in February to each Menomonee Falls property owner. The permit allows residents to dispose of yard waste 35 times in a season (April – December) for no fee at the Orchard Ridge composting facility. Please note: Village residents must provide identification showing proof of Menomonee Falls residency. Have your ID ready to show the scale house attendant upon arrival. If you do not arrive with a permit, all fees will be charged. All businesses are excluded from this program.

2025 Orchard Ridge Composting Facility Program located at N96W13073 County Line Road

- Acceptable forms of payment include credit card or check – cash no longer accepted
- Residents will be allowed one free visit per day
After the free visit, additional yard waste will be charged at a rate of \$0.015 per pound, minimum of \$3.00
- Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday, 6:30 am–4 pm & Saturday 7 am–11:45 am
- Large stumps or logs over 6" will be accepted with a fee of \$0.015 per pound, minimum of \$3.00

Dogs in Parks

Dogs are permitted in parks if they are on leashes no longer than 6 feet. The Village has 16 pet waste disposal systems in parks which include bags to pick up pet waste. It is the dog owner's responsibility to clean up after pets. Menomonee Park, which is operated by Waukesha County, has a fully fenced dog exercise area. Free Mulch

The Village manages a brush grinding operation which produces shredded wood mulch for residents. The mulch is FREE, clean, and good quality. Menomonee Falls residents can help themselves to mulch at the end of MacArthur Drive through October. See menomonee-falls.org/freemulch for a map of the pickup location.

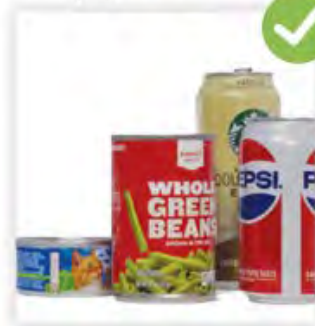

Recycling & Disposal Requirements

Things like chemicals, electronics, and appliances cannot be disposed of using your curbside collection service, so residents are encouraged to utilize the following resources to determine the most appropriate way to dispose of these types of items.

- Waukesha County has also compiled information on how to dispose of various electronics, and that information can be found at waukeshacounty.gov/recycling
- Additionally, the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay has created a *Wisconsin Recycling Markets Directory* in conjunction with the Wisconsin Department of Resources, which provides state-wide information about landfill diversion opportunities for various items. Splash Pad Open for 2025

The Kohl's Splash Pad at Village Park is now open for the 2025 season! The splash pad is activated by a touch sensor for four minute cycles, and LED lights come on at dusk. Food, drink, gum, glass, and rough play are prohibited on the splash pad. The splash pad is unsupervised, but adult supervision is recommended. The splash pad will shut down after Labor Day. Enjoy!



Park Basics

Menomonee Falls maintains [16 public parks](#) which provide a wide variety of recreation opportunities for residents and visitors. Park users should abide by the following rules:

- Park hours:
 - April - October: 6 am - 9 pm
 - November - March: 6 am - 6 pm
- Dogs allowed in the Menomonee Falls park system on a leash not exceeding 6 feet in length. Owners are responsible for picking up after dogs
- No alcohol consumption without permit
- No alcohol in athletic field areas
- No littering, removal of vegetation, disorderly conduct, or amplified broadcast beyond 20 feet
- Fires permitted in grills only. Grills are provided in Rotary Park only. Charcoal must be properly disposed of
- Tents may be erected only with the prior approval of the Village (and may require a permit)
- No moonwalks, bounce houses, inflatable structures, or slip & slides
- Power strips and extension cords are prohibited within picnic shelters

Park Shelter Reservations

All park reservations are limited to Menomonee Falls residents and must be made in person at Village Hall. For further information, please call 262-532-4201 or visit menomonee-falls.org/parkreservations



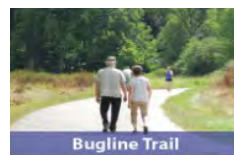

Explore Village Parks & Trails

With the longer days and warmer temperatures, now is a great time to check out some of the dozens of public parks and trails in Menomonee Falls. There are over 30 miles of trails in our community including the eastern extent of the 16 mile Bugline Recreation Trail and the Menomonee River Parkway Trail which links downtown and Rotary Park.

Our hundreds of acres of parkland offer natural beauty, athletic facilities, picnic areas, and more. For a glimpse into Village history, stroll down Main Street, stop by the Mill Pond, visit the Garwin Mace Lime Kilns, or head north to Old Falls Village Park. Old Falls Village Park is accessible for pedestrians and bicycles via the Water Street Pedestrian Bridge. Visit oldfallsvillage.com or oldfallsvillagepark.org to plan your visit.

Construction & Development Projects

Commercial Projects

Several business expansion and relocation projects have been completed across the Village in early 2025 including Boucher Ford's new car dealership and service center on Leon Road, a major building addition at Wanaki Golf Course, Wacker Neuson's new product distribution building, and Jilly's Car Wash.



Public Projects

Community Center Addition & Infrastructure Projects

Construction on the CE & Rec Community Center project started this spring. Interior renovations for the existing Community Center and Riverside Elementary are scheduled to begin this summer. The Village is moving forward with a number of street reconstruction, water main, and storm water projects this summer including major projects on Grand Avenue and Menomonee Avenue. Residential Development Update

- Menomonee Falls continues to be a leading community in the region for new home construction in 2025.
- The Metropolitan Builders Association (MBA) of Greater Milwaukee is hosting two Parade of Home sites in Menomonee Falls this summer at the Bella Vista Estates and Quietwood subdivisions.
- New single family home and duplex construction value is estimated to be \$44 million year-to-date (through May).
- Building permits have been approved for new homes in 12 different residential subdivisions so far in 2025.

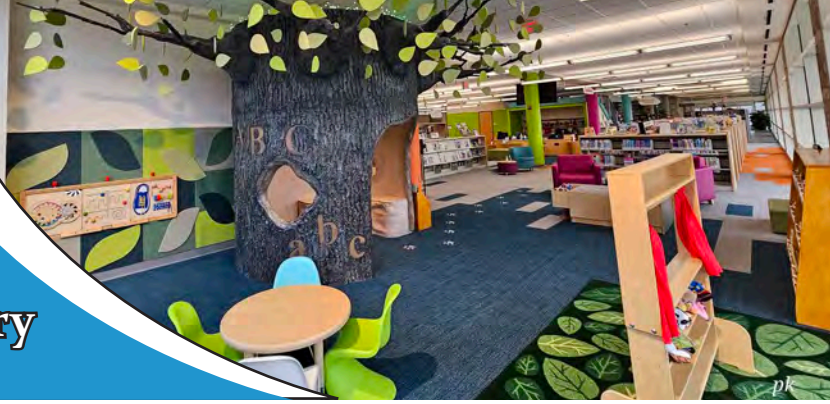


FUSSVILLE HISTORICAL MARKER

Beer Bottles and the Brewery of Fussville

Saturday, June 21, at 2 pm

Carole McGibany, local researcher, will share stories about the Fussville brewery, Vogl's Tavern, and their connection to another once successful brewery in nearby Germantown. Also, Henry Hecker, long time member of the Milwaukee Antique Bottle and Advertising Club (MABAC), will share his passionate interest in collecting and talking about the evolution of the beer bottle from 1840-1900, with an opportunity for some show and tell afterwards.

Wisconsin Was There: D-Day

On June 6, 1944, the Allies conducted the largest amphibious assault in human history. The outcome of D-Day and the days that followed ultimately led to victory in Europe. 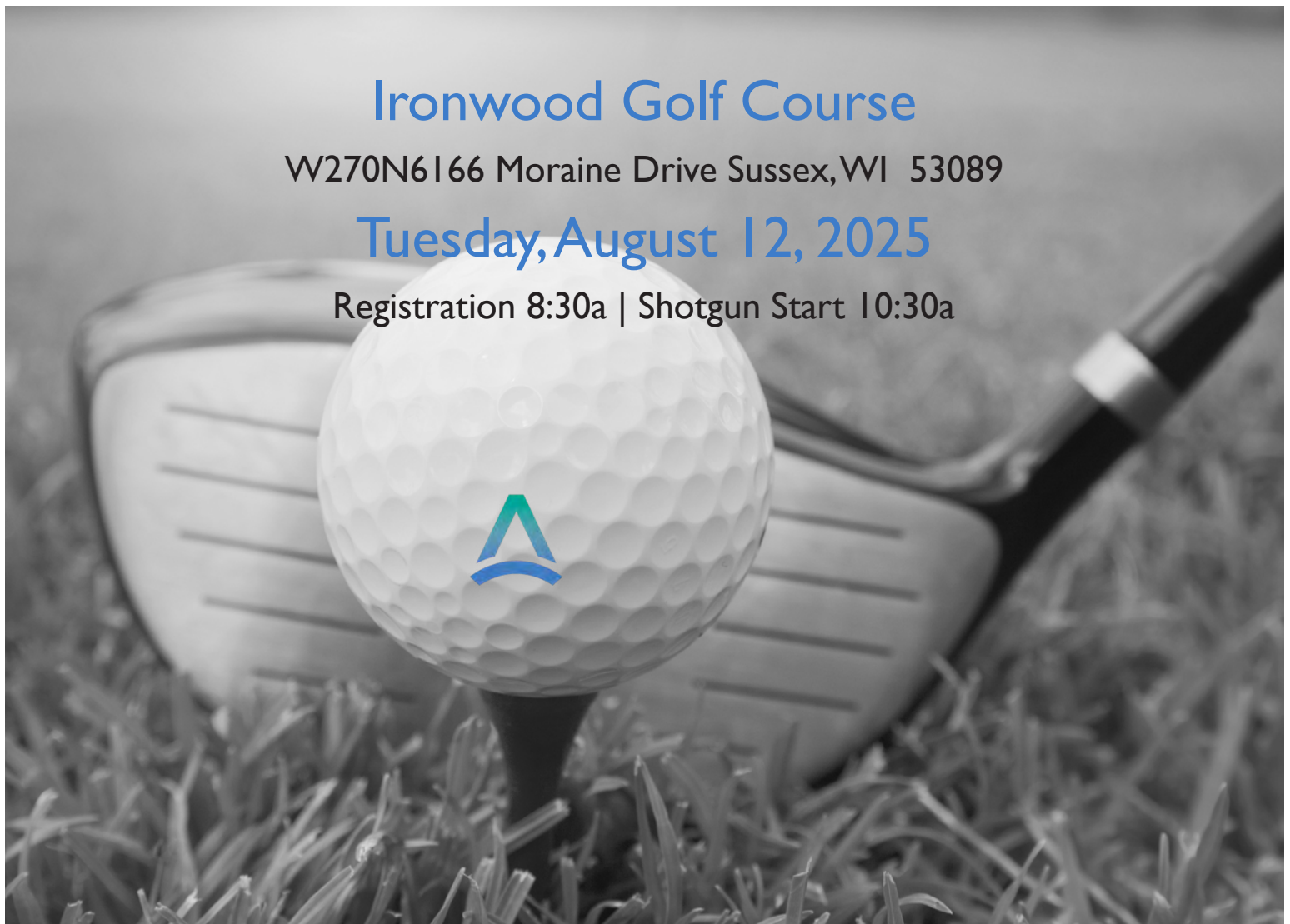

Menomonee Falls Fire Department Recognized for Outstanding Service



Menomonee Falls Fire Department recently received two awards from Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital for outstanding care provided to patients.

An ambulance from Station 97 was awarded the fastest time when treating a stroke patient. The crew was able to assess and correctly recognize symptoms of a stroke, accurately communicate that to the receiving hospital and rapidly transport the patient to the Emergency Room. These steps when done correctly allow the patient to go directly to radiology and receive a CT scan to confirm the diagnosis and receive definitive treatment.

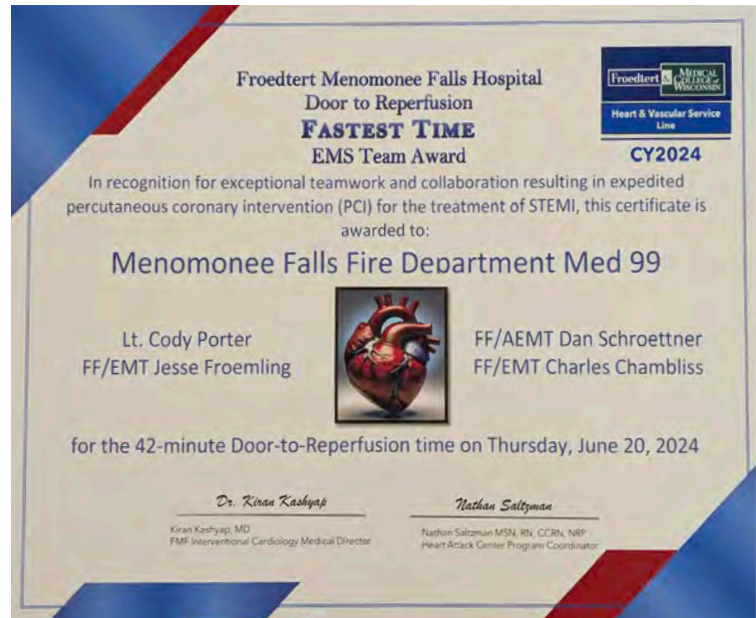
Our second award was for a patient being treated by an ambulance from Station 99. The crew assessed the patient and used an EKG to recognize a cardiac event. This information was sent to the hospital prior to arrival, allowing the receiving hospital time to prepare their catheterization lab for a patient.

The American Heart Association has set goals for the treatment of heart attacks and strokes. Menomonee Falls Fire Department has trained on these topics and regularly reviews cases to make sure we are following recommendations and where we can improve. Gear donning, hydrant water supply operation, ground ladder placement, fire engine master stream operation, and hose line advancement.



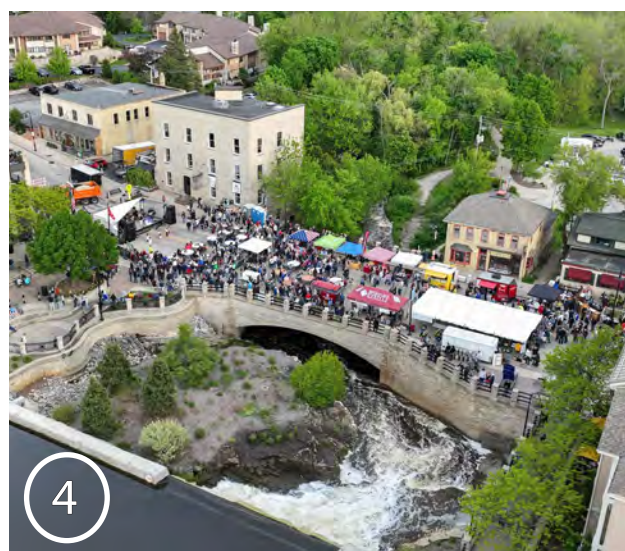
