



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of May 2025

25-010542 5-1-2025 Vehicle Pursuit

Van Buren Dr/Carol Drive

Menomonee Falls Police received a FLOCK alert for a stolen license plate on a vehicle and responded to check the area. An officer located the vehicle at Kwik Trip on Silver Spring Drive and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle fled, and a pursuit was initiated. The Brookfield Police Department assisted in the pursuit as the suspect vehicle traveled along Lisbon Road. The suspect vehicle traveled into oncoming traffic several times during the pursuit, and the Brookfield Police Department was able to successfully deploy stop sticks on the vehicle's tires in their jurisdiction. The vehicle was involved in a crash, and the driver was taken into custody by the Brookfield Police Department. The driver was turned over to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-011190 5-8-2025 Pursuit

Main St/Hwy 145

An officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a vehicle with no registration plates displayed. The vehicle fled from the officer, and a pursuit was initiated. The pursuit lasted approximately 1.1 miles before it was terminated due to unsafe speeds and driving behavior. The officer is conducting additional follow-up to attempt to locate the vehicle in question.

25-011283 5-9-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 4th Offense

Ridgeview Dr/Pilgrim Rd

A vehicle was reported disabled in front of a residence, and the responding officer contacted the driver. The driver informed the officer that the vehicle's hood had flown up and obscured the windshield while he was driving on US 41. The officer noticed signs of impairment, and the driver admitted to consuming alcohol before operating the vehicle. The officer also found that the driver's operating status was revoked and that the driver was required to have an ignition interlock device installed on the vehicle; however, there was none present. Standardized field sobriety tests were conducted, revealing several signs of impairment. The driver was arrested for operating while intoxicated – 4th offense. The driver refused to provide a chemical test of their blood, prompting the acquisition of a search warrant. The search warrant for the operator's blood was executed at Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital without incident. The driver was booked, then transported to the Waukesha County Jail and handed over to the jail staff.

25-022428 5-11-2025 Possession of Marijuana, Carrying a Concealed Weapon

Appleton Ave/Menomonee Ave

An officer conducted a traffic stop for improper display of registration plates. The officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle and conducted a probable cause search. The search revealed a package containing marijuana and a semi-automatic handgun. The driver stated he did not possess a CCW permit and was arrested. The driver was booked, posted bond, and released from custody. Charges are being referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for charging consideration.

25-011641 5-13-2025 Battery to a Law Enforcement Officer

W180N8085 Town Hall Rd

Officers were dispatched to Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital (FMFH) for the report of a disorderly person who was refusing to leave the facility. Officers contacted the individual and requested that he leave; however, he refused. As officers attempted to escort him out of the facility, he became combative and bit an officer. The individual was found to have a warrant and was arrested. The suspect was transported directly to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-011951 5-17-2025 Probation and Parole Warrant Arrest, Possession of Marijuana

N83W15700 blk Appleton Ave

An officer contacted the occupant of a vehicle parked in a handicap posted parking space without having a handicap placard displayed. The officer discovered the driver had a warrant through the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. The officer also detected the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle and conducted a probable cause search. The officer discovered marijuana, and the driver was arrested. The driver was booked and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-012108 5-18-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 1st, Possession of Marijuana

Fond Du Lac Ave/Main St

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a speeding violation and expired registration. The officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating. The driver gave consent to a search of his person, and the officer located marijuana in his pocket. A search of the vehicle yielded open intoxicants, and the driver admitted to consuming THC and alcohol. The driver submitted to standardized field sobriety tests, and the officer observed signs of impairment. The driver was arrested and consented to a legal blood draw at the hospital. The driver was booked and released to a responsible, sober adult, with charges being referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office.

25-012588 5-24-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 3rd, Resisting an Officer, Go Armed While Intoxicated, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Appleton Ave/Lilly Rd

An officer conducted a traffic stop for speeding, and the driver showed signs of possible impairment. The driver performed standardized field sobriety tests, during which signs of impairment were observed, and the driver was subsequently arrested. While officers were attempting to take the driver into custody, he tried to flee. One of the pursuing officers attempted to deploy a Taser; however, the deployment was unsuccessful. Officers were eventually able to take the driver into custody and discovered a loaded firearm in his pants pocket. They also searched the vehicle and found marijuana and drug paraphernalia. The driver was transported to Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital, where he provided a consensual blood draw. Afterwards, he was booked and released to a sober adult after posting bond on the charges. Numerous charges are being forwarded to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for review.

25-012864 5-27-2025 Prohibited Alcohol Concentration – 4th Offense, Possession of Cocaine and Drug Paraphernalia, Operating After Revocation, Possession of Open Intoxicants in a Motor Vehicle

Appleton Ave/North Hills Dr

An officer conducted a traffic stop of a vehicle with a defective headlamp. The officer discovered that the driver had a revoked driver's license and was required to have an ignition interlock device installed in the vehicle, which was not present. The officer observed an open bottle of alcohol inside the vehicle, and the driver submitted to a preliminary breath test, which indicated alcohol concentration. The driver was arrested for prohibited alcohol concentration – 4th offense. The officer searched the individual following the arrest and found cocaine and paraphernalia. The driver was booked and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-013058 5-29-2025 Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia

Fond Du Lac Ave/Menomonee River Pkwy

An officer stopped a speeding vehicle and detected the odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle while speaking with the occupants. The officer conducted a search of the vehicle for evidence of a drug law violation and located marijuana and a digital scale with marijuana residue on it. The passenger admitted ownership of the marijuana and scale and was arrested. The passenger was booked, issued municipal citations, and released from custody.
