



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of June 2025

25-013468 6-2-2025 Felony Retail Theft, Pursuit

N95W18000 Appleton Ave

Officers were dispatched to Kohl's Department Store for the report of a retail theft in progress. Two suspects were observed on surveillance footage concealing merchandise. While officers were responding, the suspects pushed out two shopping carts containing unpaid merchandise and fled in a gray pickup truck. Officers located the vehicle and attempted a traffic stop; however, the vehicle refused to stop, and a pursuit was initiated. The officer lost sight of the vehicle due to the high speed, and the pursuit was terminated after 3.3 miles. The responding officers identified one of the suspects and are attempting to locate and take him into custody.

25-013505 6-3-2025 Possession of Marijuana, Bail Jumping

Silver Spring Dr/Van Buren Dr

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a suspended registration violation. The officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle while speaking with the driver. The officer identified the driver and learned that he had several pending open cases for carrying a concealed weapon, possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia, and operating without a valid driver's license. The officer conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle to locate evidence of a drug violation. The officer located marijuana, and the driver was arrested. The driver was booked and transported to the Waukesha County Jail. Charges for possession of marijuana and bail jumping were referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for charging consideration.

25-013605 6-4-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 3rd Offense, Resisting an Officer, Probation Violation

Roosevelt Dr/Charles Dr

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a stop sign violation. As the vehicle came to a stop, the driver exited and fled from the officer on foot. The officer pursued the driver through several residential backyards and took him into custody. The driver performed standardized field sobriety tests, and the officer observed indicators of impairment. The driver refused to provide a consensual blood draw. The officer received a signed warrant to obtain the driver's blood for evidentiary purposes. The driver was booked and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-014589 6-13-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 1st Offense, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Main St/Christman Rd

An officer conducted a traffic stop of a vehicle driving without the headlamps illuminated during the evening hours. The driver showed signs of impairment and submitted to standardized field sobriety tests. The officer observed more signs of impairment, and the driver was arrested for operating while intoxicated. A Waukesha County Sheriff's Department K9 unit responded to the scene and conducted a K9 sniff of the vehicle. The K9 alerted the handler and the officer conducted a probable cause search. The officer located a digital scale with drug residue present, a large sum of US currency, a several cellular phones. The driver submitted to an evidentiary chemical test of his blood. The driver was booked, cited, and released to a sober adult.

25-014751 6-16-2025 Operating After Revocation, Failure to Install an Ignition Interlock Device, Bail Jumping, Warrant Arrest

14800 Block/County Line Rd

An officer, with prior knowledge of an individual's driving status, observed the driver traveling in the 14800 block of County Line Rd. The officer contacted the driver after the driver parked the vehicle and confirmed the driver's operating status to be revoked due to an operating while intoxicated violation. The officer also determined that the driver had a pending criminal case with bail restrictions and a warrant for his arrest. The officer did not observe that the vehicle had a required ignition interlock device installed within the vehicle. The officer took the driver into custody and transported him to the Menomonee Falls Police Department for booking procedures. The driver was transported and turned over to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-014810 6-16-2025 Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Pilgrim Rd/Mill Rd

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle operating with a defective headlamp during the hours of darkness. The officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. The officer conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle; however, nothing of evidentiary value was located. An officer conducted a consensual search of the passenger and removed a loaded, semi-automatic handgun from their person. The passenger admitted they did not possess a valid CCW permit to possess the firearm. The officer took the passenger into custody and also located a marijuana pipe and suspected marijuana on their person. The passenger was booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

A business in the 8700 block of Lilly Rd reported a burglary between June 16, 2025, and June 17, 2025. A riding lawnmower was taken during the burglary. A detective responded to the scene and is investigating the circumstances.

Officers were dispatched to a residence for the report of an uncontrollable juvenile, breaking household items and assaulting a parent. As officers arrived, they attempted to detain the juvenile; however, the juvenile shoved and struck an officer, causing him pain. The juvenile was subsequently arrested without further incident. The juvenile was transported to the Menomonee Falls Police Department for booking procedures. The juvenile was transported to a juvenile intake center and turned over to staff.

25-015260 6-20-2025 Eluding Causing Great Bodily Harm, Possession of Marijuana, Operating a Motor Vehicle While Suspended Causing Injury

An officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop of a vehicle for a speeding violation. The vehicle failed to stop, extinguished its lights, and violated a red traffic signal, which caused a motor vehicle crash with another motorist. The suspect suffered injuries and was transported to a hospital for treatment. The occupant of the other vehicle also sustained injuries and was transported to a hospital for treatment. The suspect was cleared from the hospital and transported to the Menomonee Falls Police Department for booking. The suspect was turned over to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-015265 6-20-2025 Motor Vehicle Crash - Hit and Run Causing Injury

Lost Pond Ct/Lost Pond Dr

Officers responded to the report of a motor vehicle crash causing injury to a pedestrian. Upon arrival, officers learned that a citizen confronted several juveniles who were toilet papering his residence. The citizen chased the juveniles off his property, and they fled to a nearby vehicle. As the juveniles entered the vehicle and attempted to flee, the driver of the vehicle struck the citizen, causing non-life-threatening injuries. The citizen was transported to the hospital for treatment. A detective responded to the scene to investigate and was able to locate the striking vehicle nearby.

25-015322 6-21-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 3rd Offense, Probation Violation

15000 Block/Falls Parkway

An officer located a disabled vehicle stopped in traffic and contacted the driver. The officer observed open intoxicants within the vehicle and detected signs of impairment. The driver performed standardized field sobriety tests, and more signs of impairment were detected. The driver was arrested for operating while intoxicated – 3rd offense. The driver was on probation at the time of contact, and the Department of Corrections placed a probation hold on the driver. The driver was booked and the Menomonee Falls Police Department and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-015738 6-26-2025 Carrying a Concealed Weapon

Leon Rd/124th St

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a speeding violation. The driver admitted to the officer that a firearm was concealed within the vehicle and that the driver did not possess a valid CCW permit. The officer located the firearm underneath the driver's seat, and the driver was subsequently arrested for carrying a concealed weapon. The driver was booked, posted bond, and released from the Menomonee Falls Police Department.

25-015996 6-28-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 1st Offense, Resisting an Officer

Creekwood Crossing/Bette Dr

Officers responded to the report of a vehicle crash and located a vehicle partially submerged in a pond. Officers contacted the driver, who admitted to consuming alcohol before driving the vehicle. The driver submitted to standardized field sobriety tests, and the officers detected signs of impairment. The driver was arrested for operating while intoxicated – 1st offense. After the driver was arrested, he became physically uncooperative with officers and began slamming his head on the squad window. Officers physically restrained the driver to prevent him from harming himself. The driver was transported to the hospital for medical clearance. Once the driver was medically cleared, the City of Brookfield Police Department responded with a restraint vehicle, which allowed officers to transport the driver safely to the Waukesha County Jail, where custody was turned over to jail staff.

25-016185 6-30-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 1st Offense, Possession of Marijuana

15700 Block/Appleton Ave

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a registration violation. The officer detected smoke and an odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle upon contacting the driver. The driver admitted to smoking marijuana before being stopped. The officer conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and located the marijuana. The driver performed standardized field sobriety tests, and the officer detected signs of impairment. The driver was transported to the Menomonee Falls Police Department for booking procedures. The driver was discovered to be on probation, and the Department of Corrections placed a probation hold on the driver. The driver was transported and turned over to the Waukesha County Jail staff.
