



Menomonee Falls Police Department Notable Incidents for the Month of November 2025

25-028204 & 25-028208 11-2-2025 Felony Retail Theft

N95W18000 Appleton Ave & N95W17700 blk Shady Ln

On 11-2-2025, two individuals committed a retail theft at Kohl's Department Store and proceeded to walk past the last point of sale without attempting to pay for the merchandise. Both individuals then traveled to Target, where they committed another retail theft. As they were passing the last point of sale, Target loss prevention staff confronted both of them. One of the suspects remained on scene, while the second suspect fled from the business. Officers responded to the area and located the second suspect attempting to leave the area in an Uber. Both suspects were arrested. Officers located a vehicle that the suspects arrived in that contained additional stolen merchandise from Walmart in Germantown. The Germantown Police Department was notified and confirmed with Walmart that a retail theft occurred. The Germantown Police Department cited both suspects. Menomonee Falls officers transported the suspects to the Menomonee Falls Police Department for booking procedures. After booking, both suspects were transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-028314 11-4-2025 Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Possession of Marijuana, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Silver Spring Dr/Campbell Dr

An officer conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle equipment violation. As the officer contacted the driver, the officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. The officer conducted a probable cause search and located marijuana, drug paraphernalia, and a loaded semi-automatic handgun in the vehicle. The driver did not possess a valid CCW permit and was arrested. The driver was booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department and released from custody. Charges have been referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for review.

25-028982 11/10/2025 Theft from Motor Vehicles

N91W15800 blk Falls Pkwy & N88W14700 blk Main St

An unidentified suspect(s) forced entry into several vehicles parked at Home 2 Suites and the Delta Hotel. The suspect(s) stole several thousand dollars' worth of tools from the vehicles. A field evidence technician responded to the scenes to process and collect evidence. The investigation remains ongoing.

25-028473 11-5-2025 Operating While Intoxicated – 2nd Offense, Resisting

Shady Ln/Tamarack Trail

Officers were dispatched to check the welfare of a motorist on Tamarack Trail near Shady Ln. Upon their arrival, officers observed the motorist seated in a vehicle and showed signs of possible impairment. The driver performed standardized field sobriety tests, and officers observed additional signs of impairment. The driver was told that he was under arrest for operating while intoxicated; however, he refused to comply with the officer's commands. Officers gained control of the driver and took him into custody. The driver was transported to Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital, and he refused to provide an evidentiary blood test. Officers obtained a signed search warrant, and hospital staff obtained the blood samples. The driver was transported to the Menomonee Falls Police Department for booking, then released to a responsible, sober adult. Charges have been referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for review.

25-029115 11/12/2025 Resisting/Obstructing a Law Enforcement Officer

W166N9100 Grand Ave

Officers responded to the report of a disturbance between several individuals at a residence on Grand Ave. As officers arrived, they were met by the reporting person, who stated that the suspect had initially refused to leave the reporting person's residence and struck her in the face. The reporting person directed officers to check the back of the building, where the suspect may be hiding in the bushes. Officers checked the rear of the building and located two individuals, a male and a female. The male displayed strange behavior as officers approached him, and he seemed disoriented and confused. Officers gave him verbal directions to get on the ground; however, he ignored the commands and displayed behavior consistent with pre-attack posturing. An officer deployed a conducted electronic weapon, commonly referred to as a "Taser", to gain control of this individual. The deployment was successful, and officers were able to take the individual into custody without any further incident. The suspect was transported to Froedtert Menomonee Falls Hospital for medical clearance, as he appeared to be under the influence of an unknown substance. After being medically cleared, the suspect was booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-029205 11-13-2025 Fatal Motor Vehicle Accident

US I41 / Hwy145

Officers responded to the report of a significant motor vehicle crash on Interstate 41 at US Highway 145. The investigation revealed that a two-vehicle crash occurred involving a sport utility vehicle and a semi-truck and trailer. The operator and sole occupant of the sport utility vehicle, a 47-year-old female, was pronounced deceased at the scene. The exact cause of the crash remains under investigation.

25-029353 11-15-2025 Bail Jumping, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Hallucinogenic Mushrooms, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Pilgrim Rd/Megal Ct

Officers observed a motorist asleep in a vehicle in the parking lot located at Pilgrim Rd and Megal Ct. An officer went to check on the occupant and observed suspected hallucinogenic mushrooms in plain view within the vehicle. The driver woke up and opened his door, at which time the officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. Officers searched the vehicle and found psilocybin mushrooms and a THC vape pen. The driver was arrested, and officers learned the driver had an open circuit court case for possession of marijuana and carrying a concealed weapon with bail conditions. The driver was booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department and released from custody. Charges have been referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for a charging determination.

25-029500 11-17-2025 Substantial Battery

W124N8145 Highway 145

Officers were dispatched to Woodman's Food Market for the report of a battery complaint. The investigation revealed that the victim was punched several times in the face by a known suspect. The victim was transported to Ascension Hospital for treatment of his facial injuries. Officers made phone contact with the suspect, and he agreed to come to the Menomonee Falls Police Department to speak with officers. The suspect arrived and stated that the victim allegedly owed the suspect money. The suspect admitted that a verbal confrontation occurred when he saw the victim in Woodman's, and the suspect assaulted the victim. The suspect was arrested, booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department, and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-030209 11-25-2025 Bail Jumping, Obstructing Police, Absolute Sobriety

Woodland Dr/Terrace Dr

An officer observed a motorcyclist operating a motorcycle that did not have a registration plate displayed or working lights and conducted a traffic stop to investigate the violations. The officer checked the VIN of the motorcycle and discovered that the motorcycle had been stolen through the St. Louis (MO) Police Department. The motorcyclist verbally identified himself to officers, and officers detected the odor of intoxicants emanating from his person. The motorist was arrested, and officers later learned, after checking his fingerprints, that he provided his brother's identification information as his own. Once officers correctly identified him, they discovered the suspect had 2 open felony cases, and he was found to be in violation of his bail conditions for those cases. The suspect was transported to the police department for booking procedures before being turned over to the Waukesha County Jail.

25-030454 11-28-2025 Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Going Armed While Intoxicated, Obstructing Police, Operating While Intoxicated – 1st Offense, Warrant Arrest, Bail Jumping

Main St/Westbrook Crossing

An officer conducted a traffic stop of a vehicle after it was observed traveling westbound in the eastbound lanes of traffic. The driver and sole occupant provided the officer with a Wisconsin identification card belonging to another person. The driver displayed signs of intoxication and performed standardized field sobriety tests. Officers observed additional indicators of impairment, and the driver was arrested for operating while intoxicated. Officers searched the vehicle after they also detected the odor of burnt marijuana emanating from within and located a semi-automatic handgun and an open bottle of alcohol. The driver was later found to have two open circuit court cases and two warrants for her arrest. The driver was booked at the Menomonee Falls Police Department and transported to the Waukesha County Jail.
