

February 2017 Selected Reports of MFPD:

The following are the more notable incidents occurring in the past month.

17-245 Retail theft:

Review of video surveillance found a theft had occurred on Jan 31 at 11:02am. A male suspect removed beer and liquor from the liquor department. Suspect was seen leaving in a small black vehicle. DL Photo of registered owner does not match suspect on video.

17-0258 Retail Theft:

On 02/07/2017, at 3:57 p.m., two males removed two shopping carts containing groceries and merchandise from Woodman's. A plate was obtained and the registered owner is a Milwaukee man listing on a the 2002 Chrysler Sebring, however, the suspect vehicle was a gray '90's to early 2000's model Buick Le Sabre or Century with no distinct markings or damage.

17-0266 Retail Theft:

An adult male entered Target on 02-11-17, selected two items and removed them from their packaging. Def then concealed the items in his coat and attempted to leave the store without payment. Def was stopped by Target LP and admitted to the theft. The Def had a handgun on him with a CCW permit. The permit was found to be expired within the last two weeks. Def was arrested for Muni retail theft and carrying a concealed weapon, taken to MFPD, booked provided a statement, cited and released.

17-0281 Retail Theft:

Home Goods LP detained a woman for retail theft. The defendant fell to the ground and possibly suffered a medical emergency. She had outstanding warrants. MFFD ambo was summoned and transported the woman for medical treatment. She was taken to the WKSJ jail on 1 misdemeanor retail theft, 4 counts of misdemeanor bail jumping, and the 4 warrants.

17-0302 Retail Theft:

Woodman's reported two retail thefts. The first theft occurred on 2-18-17 and the second theft on 2-19-2017. A male suspect was observed stealing 17 cases of Red Bull Energy Drinks. The theft appears to be related to a prior theft as well.

17-0306 Retail Theft:

On 2/20/17 at 8:11 p.m., two unknown males pushed a shopping cart full of grocery items out of Woodman's. Merchandise appeared to be baby diapers, crab legs, and laundry detergent. The suspects fled in a dark grey 1990 Geo Prizm.

17-0307 Retail Theft:

A Retail Theft in Progress at Woodman's. Two male suspects hid two cases of Red Bull energy drink inside a backpack and left without paying. Suspects and Vehicle description (2004 Buick Century, 4d, Gray) matched multiple Retail Thefts at the same location in the past several days (Case 17-0302). PO located the vehicle after the Suspects fled W/B Leon Rd and pursued it into the City of Milwaukee. Pursuit was terminated at 91st St / W. Flagg Ave.

17-0311 Retail Theft:

On 2/19/17, at Penny Mustard, an unknown actor(s) removed a purse from the business office and used a debit card to make unauthorized purchases at Best Buy and the CVS Store, both in Menomonee Falls. A suspicious male and female were seen near the office area on 2/19. Video surveillance is available from all 3 locations.

17-0322 Theft of Gas:

Gas drive-off at Good to Go Quick Mart. The driver of a silver Jeep Grand Cherokee pumped 18 gallons of fuel and left e/b on Main St making no attempt to pay. Follow up being conducted into the registered owner of the plate that was obtained.

17-0231 Motor Vehicle Theft:

A Blk 2005 KIA Avanti was taken from a residence without his permission. The suspect was known to the victim. While taking report, officers were sent to Walgreens (N) for a suspicious subject in the bathroom. The known suspect was found there and the veh was parked in the lot. Investigation found the suspect to be in possession of the veh keys, as well as Heroin, Drug Paraphernalia, and a credit card belonging to the victim. He was taken WKSO Jail, and charged with Operate MV w/o owners consent, Poss Heroin, Identity Theft, Theft, Poss Drug Paraphernalia.

17-0241 Obstructing an Officer:

On 02-05-17, at 5:11am, an adult male was arrested for Obstructing an Officer after he allegedly reported his vehicle stolen from the lot of AJ O'Brady's. It was determined that his vehicle had become disabled after he drove it into a nearby park.

17-0333 Motor Vehicle Theft:

Victim advised that her vehicle, a maroon Pontiac Montana minivan, was stolen with keys at around 3am on 02-25-17. The suspect was a live-in friend. The male friend did not have permission to use the car and sent a text to the victim advising he would bring it back, but did not follow through. The vehicle was entered into NCIC as stolen.
